

Dear Resident,

The HOA Board and Management are aware of several community landscaping issues and we are working with our contractors to rectify.

Clover (small white flowering weeds) and a few other varieties have begun to appear in our lawns. Lawns by Yorkshire will be treating these areas next week. We have also requested they mow more evenly as we've noticed sections of lawn that were not mowed properly. We have also instructed them to clear the sidewalks more consistently and not leave debris until the next day.

Secondly, our ponds need to be treated more aggressively for algae growth and elimination of floating vegetation. Our pond vendor is scheduled to be onsite June 20 for chemical treatment of algae growth and we are discussing more aggressive and consistent upkeep of the ponds.

Lastly, we had delayed the startup of the front fountain to facilitate repair of the cracks in the sign. Pulte recently completed these repairs and we are expecting the fountain vendor here shortly to start this up.
