

The Florham Park Post Office has asked Pulte to make changes to the single family home mailboxes. As many are aware, the mailboxes are not positioned in numeric order and this is contributing to errors by the mail carrier.

Pulte will be making these changes. It's important for all single family homeowners to read this communication in its entirety.

All mail should be removed from your mailbox on July 5 (USPS will collect mail left behind and will redeliver). The work will take place on July 6 and July 7. During this time, there will not be mail delivery. This doesn't affect other carriers like UPS, FedEx and Amazon Logistics. Only USPS.

Mail will be available on July 8 in your newly located mailbox.

Residents do not need to turn in their keys. The locks are being moved by Pulte. In addition, the two mailbox clusters used for Broom Drive will be relocated to the clubhouse area next to the existing clusters for Applegate and Del Webb Drive. The remaining mailbox clusters located on Doyle will be relocated to Hadley next to the existing mailbox clusters.

This only affects single family homes. Mailboxes belonging to Townhomes and Flats are not being relocated.
